Abstracts

Abstracts may be original research, insight, reviews or case studies.

- Must be original work
- Submitted in Microsoft Word format
- A maximum of 300 words. Word count does not include title or authors and affiliations.
- Do not include references
- Must contain title of presentation
- List of author(s) names and affiliations
- Name, address, telephone number and email address of contact person
- Contact person must be registered for the Symposium

- Time allocation 5 minutes plus 2 minutes questions.

- Posters must be
- A0 size (841x1189 mm)
- must be portrait orientation
- Prepared in a form that this easily mounted for display
- Must include title, authors and the institution(s) or origin
